



Information provided in compliance with art. 13 D. Law. 196/2003 (Data Protection act)

Parker Hiross S.p.A strongly believes in preserving the confidentiality of personal data that is entrusted to it and ensures that the processing of personal data shall take place without prejudice to fundamental rights or freedoms, with full respect for the dignity of all concerned, with particular consideration being paid to issues of confidentiality, personal identity as well as the right to protection of one's personal data.

It also believes that it is important to provide information on how personal data is processed and to what end.

Scope of this Data Protection document

This information concerning Data Protection applies to all personal data provided during the course of this registration.

1. Purposes of personal data processing.

These data are processed exclusively in connection with the performance of the business activities of Parker Hiross S.p.A. and in particular for: (i) inclusion in anagraphic and company database systems; (ii) for the issue of quotes or offers for current and/or potential clients; (iii) for the issue of enquiries to current and/or potential suppliers; (iv) for the elaboration of internal statistical data (v) for the exchange of communications concerning the economic, administrative and commercial business of the company by telephone, post, courier, fax, e-mail and by means of confidential and access protected pages on its own web site.

The data may also be processed, subject to prior consent, in the drawing up of reports and research, marketing statistics, for the mailing of advertising and informational material, for direct sales activities or placing of products or services, for the posting of commercial offers as well as carrying out any other activity of a commercial and/or advertising nature connected with the company's business even by means of computer or electronic systems such as Internet or electronic mail.

2. Data communication

The personal data of the interested parties, where necessary, may be communicated to: (i) all parties whose permission to access this data is granted by normative measures; (ii) our collaborators, in the performance of their duties (iii) to other partner companies; (iv) to post offices, freighters or couriers for sending documentation and/or material; (v) to all those physical and/or corporate bodies, be they public and/or private (legal, administrative or tax consulting firms, firms specializing in employment consulting for the compilation of pay checks, Judicial offices, Chambers of Commerce, Labor Exchanges and Offices, etc.), when the communication of the data is considered necessary or expedient for the performance of our business and the form and to the ends indicated above; (v) to banking institutions for the management of collection and payments that may ensue in the execution of contracts. In these instances the data communicated shall be exclusively those required in order to achieve the aims for which they are being communicated.

3. Conferment of data and refusal to do so

The conferment of personal data, by parties intending to enter into a commercial relationship with our company, even if purely for information purposes concerning our activities/services, should be considered optional, but where the data is not provided this may result in the termination of the relationship or have a bearing on its correct performance and on any legal and fiscal obligations. The data is held in our company's main offices, for the term prescribed by civil and fiscal legislation.

4. Data processing mode

The processing of personal data is performed using both paper based and computer systems in compliance with all precautionary measures, in order to ensure their safety and confidentiality. Parker Hiross S.p.A. uses a number of different secure techniques for the protection of personal data, such as identification numbers, passwords, secure servers, firewalls, antivirus programs and procedures and the encoding of the application data and all Internet communications.

5. Cookie

Cookies may be used to make site navigation by visitors less time consuming and to offer efficient registration procedures. Cookies are text files that are written on the visitor's hard disk by a web server. The web browser is installed on the visitor's computer, and is usually set up to accept Cookies automatically. It is, however, usually possible to modify this setting. In most cases, a visitor can refuse a Cookie and continue to navigate our site without any problem.

When visitors access our Web site to consult, read or download information, we collect and keep a record of a certain information on the visitor, such as the dominion and host name with which Internet access has been made, the Internet Protocol (IP) address of the computer used for access, the date and time of access to our site and the Internet addresses of the sites from which connection directly to our sites was achieved. We process this information for security reasons, in order to measure the traffic on our site and in order to improve its efficiency. This information is deleted on a regular basis.

6. Responsibility for the data processing

The Data Controller for personal data is Parker Hiross S.p.A. in the person of the pro tempore authorized representative, Via Zona Industriale 4 – 35020 Sant'Angelo di Piove di Sacco (PD).

7. Changes

Parker Hiross S.p.A. reserves the right to change or correct this Data Protection document at any time. The date on which this Data Protection document comes into force is indicated at the beginning of the document itself.

8. The rights of the interested party

The interested party has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or lack thereof of any personal data that concern it, even though they may not yet be registered, and obtain a copy of said data in a clearly intelligible form.

The interested party also has the right to obtain indications as to: (i) the origins of the personal data, its purpose and mode of processing; (ii) the criteria used in the event that the processing is performed using electronic means; (iii) all information and details relating to the company responsible for the processing, the data controller and the representative as appointed pursuant to article 5, paragraph 2 of the legislative decree n. 196 of 2003; (iv) the subjects or range of subjects to which this personal data may be communicated or who may become acquainted with them such as the representative appointed in the territory of the State, the data controller or those entrusted with the processing.

The interested party has the right to obtain: (i) the updating, rectification or, if it so requires, the integration of the data; (ii) the removal, the transformation into an anonymous form or the blocking of data processed in violation of the law, including those that need not be held in order to achieve the objectives for which the data has originally been collected or subsequently processed.

The interested party has the right to totally or partially oppose: (i) the processing of the personal data that concern it, given reasonable grounds, even when said data is relevant to the objectives of the data collection; (ii) the processing of personal data that concern it for the purposes of mailing of advertising or direct sales material or for carrying out market research or commercial communications.
